This term we are embarking on a theme called 'Frozen World'. As part of this theme, the children will explore all things cold on our Earth. - Homework sheet Every Wednesday your child will be given a homework sheet with a variety of activities you can complete at home which will related to the learning in class. Please return homework on Monday.

In Reception we love to be outside, no matter what the weather. Please make sure your child brings their coat in every day, even if it looks dry, the weather can change. As the weather becomes colder, they will also need hats and gloves and wellies when it is wet.
