LIVING WITH COVID

The Government has again updated its guidance regarding living with COVID. As the population now has much stronger protection against COVID, the advice is that we can begin to manage the virus like other respiratory infections. Therefore, children who are unwell and have a high temperature should stay at home and avoid contact with other people. They can come back to school when they no longer have a high temperature and they are well enough to attend. Adults with a positive COVID test result should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 5 days, which is when they are most infectious. For children and young people aged 18 and under, the advice will be 3 days.
