

Remote Learning Plan

In the event of a pupil testing positive for Coronavirus and a class bubble having to close for two weeks so that pupils can self-isolate, a remote learning plan will be put into place.

Teachers will plan a timetable for the two weeks which will be emailed to parents, as well as being added to the class page on the school website.

The plan will include activities to develop reading, English (handwriting, writing, spelling and grammar) and maths; as well as other subjects including RE, PSHE, Science, creative activities and humanities.

Teachers may include a video link in the planning which will aid pupils in completing the activity, or a video of themselves modelling a method or explaining a task to the class. Weekly plans will link to lessons from websites such as White Rose Maths, NCETM, Oak National Academy, Purple Mash, BBC Bitesize and Times Tables Rock Stars. Explanations for each activity will be made as clear as possible on daily plans so that families without internet access can still participate in activities.

Children will also receive workbooks to write in (currently on order), and the teacher will explain which pages need to be completed on particular days. The teacher will then display answers on the website or via email when necessary.

Questions, requests for help and evidence of work (including photos, word documents, powerpoints) can be emailed to the class teacher and class TA who will provide regular support and feedback with regards to the children's work and general well-being.

If a child has specific needs in certain areas, their work will be modified and adapted by the class teacher to ensure that all pupils are able to access activities and gain a sense of achievement at completing tasks.

In the event of the whole school having to shut for a period of time, remote learning will be available from the following day, and children will be given workbooks to work from.
