Dear Parents/Carers

In the event that we enter another lockdown related to the pandemic, here is some relevant information for you and your child relating to accessing TEAMS lessons.

If you have a question about the TEAMS lessons, please email the class teacher directly rather than asking during the lesson as the teachers will be concentrating on communicating with all the children who have joined the meeting.

Below is a timetable of how we plan on delivering the TEAMS lessons. The lesson times will also be shown on the class timetables on the website. These are organised so that if children are sharing a device, the lessons will not overlap.

Teachers will keep a record of which children join the meetings as evidence of who is engaging in their learning. There is an expectation that children join at least one of the lessons every day.

Daily Check-in – Short chat with the teacher explaining what they want the class to do that day, and seeing how everyone is. Time for friends to see each other on screen.

This timetable gives each class from Y2-Y6 two daily opportunities for live meetings, and a third longer session. Younger children will be provided with workpacks and activities on their class pages.

I will keep you informed of any changes or adaptations needed.
